The ECCC

The ECCC is the engine for the implementation of Europe's strategy in research, innovation, and industrial policy in the area of cybersecurity.



The ECCC

- established with Regulation (EU) 2021/887 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 May 2021.
- The ECCC financial autonomy is foreseen by Q3/2024.
- The ECCC premises are located at the **Polytechnic University in Bucharest - CAMPUS Centre**, and its operations have been carried out from there in a temporary office **since 09.05.2023**.
- The permanent premises will be delivered in Q2/Q3-2024.
- As of 01.03.2024, the ECCC will have 30 staff member out of 38 foreseen in the regulation.

- ✓ Reinforce **EU leadership and strategic autonomy**.
- ✓ Support the Union's **technological capacities**.
- ✓ Increase the global **competitiveness of the Union's cybersecurity industry**.



OBJECTIVES

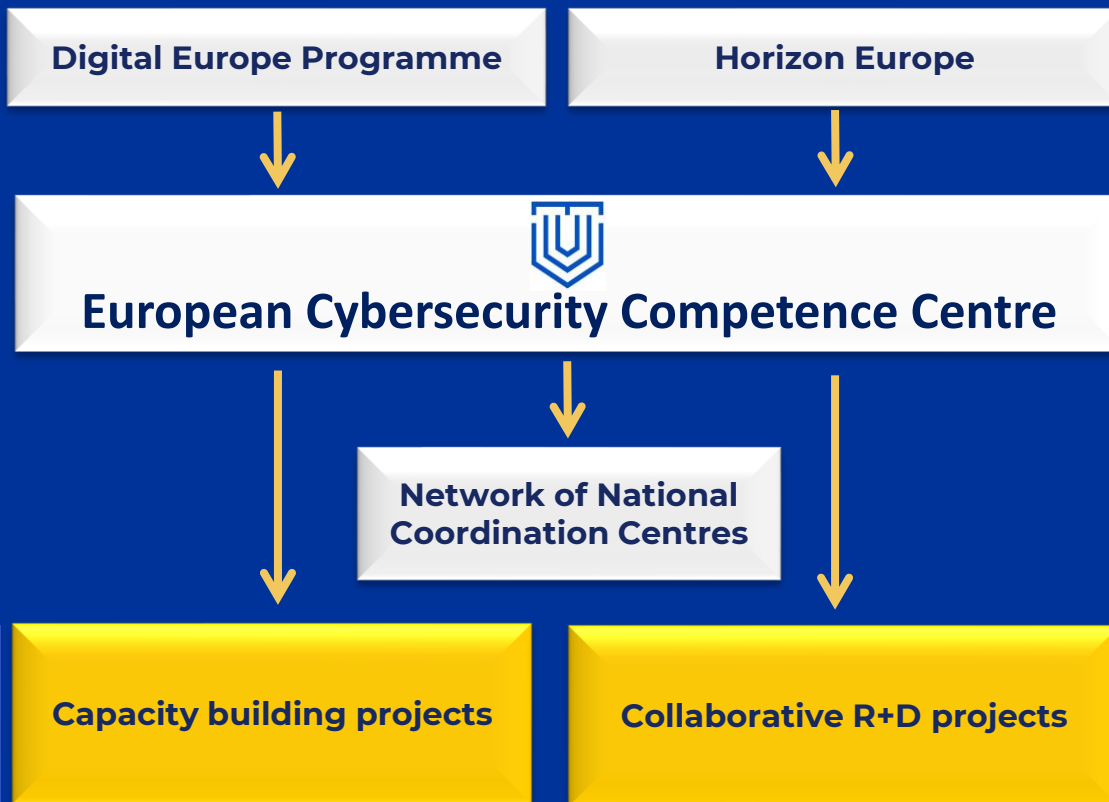
- ✓ Enhance cybersecurity capacities, capabilities, knowledge and infrastructure.
- ✓ Promote **cybersecurity resilience** and the uptake of cybersecurity best practices.
- ✓ **Contribute to a strong European cybersecurity ecosystem that brings together all relevant stakeholders**.



IMPLEMENTATION

- ✓ Developing and monitoring the implementation of the **Strategic Agenda**.
- ✓ Managing cybersecurity-related financial support from **Horizon Europe** and **Digital Europe Programme**.
- ✓ Facilitating and coordinating the work of the **NCCs Network**.
- ✓ Where relevant and appropriate, acquiring and operating ICT infrastructures and services.

Co-investment by Member States (voluntary)

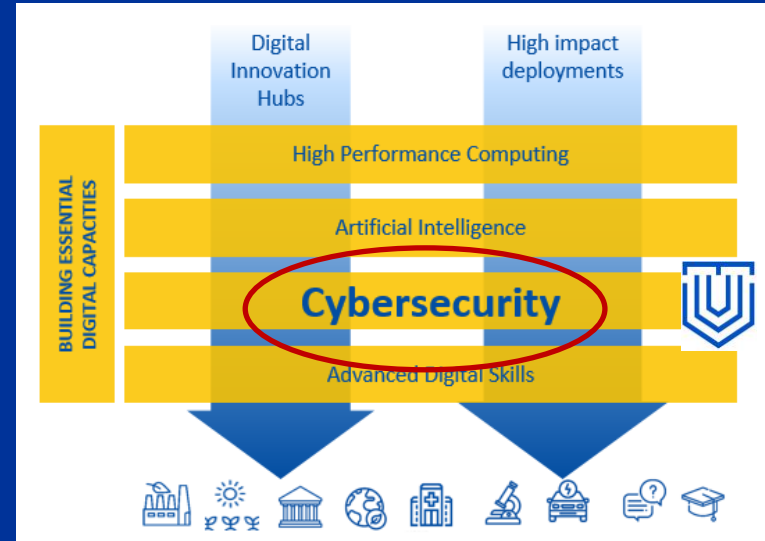
Digital Europe Programme framework

(327 M € for WP2021-22 + 375 M € of WP 2023-24).

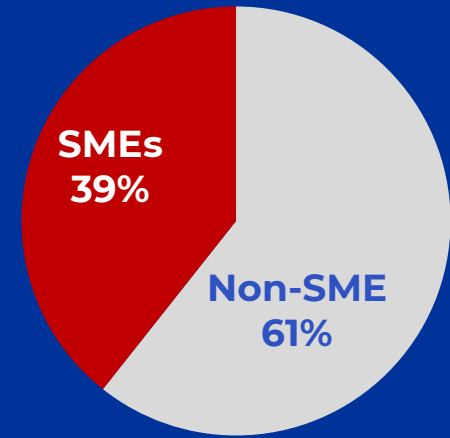
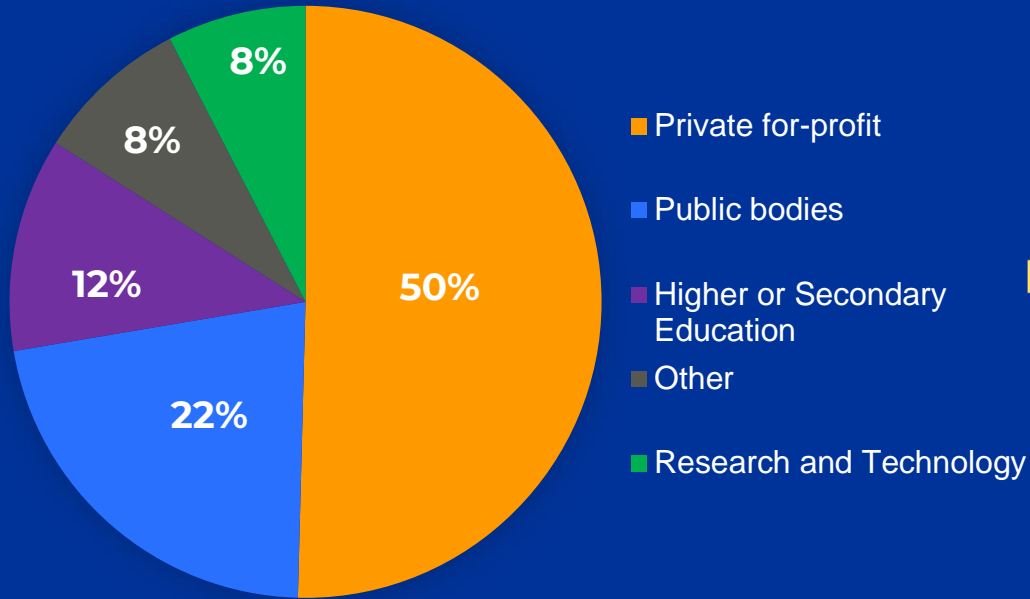

Examples of ongoing projects under DEP



- ✓ **SOCshare aims to strengthen SOC in Lithuania** and elsewhere in Europe, to react more quickly to cyber-attacks and to share the obtained information.
- ✓ **Achievements:** created and shared 60 cyber threat intelligence datasets some of which actively helped protect from cyberattacks, by detecting and blocking intrusion attempts of threat-actors in business environment



- ✓ **ASCLEPIUS project aims to tackle the EU cybersecurity preparedness** and provide greater cyber protection to **help strengthen Europe healthcare** sector after the Covid-19 crisis.
- ✓ **Achievements:** developing of a cyber maturity assessment, with the aim to analyze current capabilities and processes of the organization for maintaining cybersecurity.

ECCC – Next steps

DEP

- ECCC will assume full implementation of **DEP – Objective 3 “Cybersecurity and Trust”**.

HORIZON EUROPE

ECCC will also assume the cybersecurity destination of **cluster 3**.

SOCs

Solid contribution to developing the **European Cyber Shield**, thanks to a budget of around 90 M€ dedicated to further actions for building capacities of SOC_s (DEP WP 2023-2024”).

Upcoming WPs

- The **Strategic Agenda (SA)** provides input for drafting **DEP and Horizon WP**.
- The drafting of the WP 2025-27 starting now.
- The **SA “Action Plan”** in progress.
